**Co-Parenting Effectively Serves Best Interests of Children**

**How Do I Make Smart Decisions About Co-Parenting?**

**How Does Effective Co-Parenting Help Me Obtain Custody?**

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- ✓ 1. Time with the other parent is usually best for your children. If you believe time with the other parent should be restricted, discuss the reasons with your lawyer.
- ✓ 2. Take steps to ensure that time spent with the other parent is successful. When appropriate, prepare a medication schedule, send homework to be completed and so on.
- ✓ 3. Don't engage in conduct that could alienate your children from the other parent or ask them to choose sides. Put your ill-will aside.
- ✓ 4. Speak positively of the other parent in front of the children.
- ✓ 5. Don't speak poorly about the other parent's family in front of the children.
- ✓ 6. If extra time with the other parent is requested and if your children want the extra time, give serious consideration to allowing it.
- ✓ 7. Don't move out of the family home if you want to have custody.
- ✓ 8. If feasible or if required by the custody order, jointly parent by keeping the other parent informed and in the loop. Email is an effective means of communication.
- ✓ 9. Establish a relationship with a family counsellor or an individual counsellor.
- ✓ 10. Give consideration to allowing your children to spend time with the other parent's extended family.
- ✓ 11. Be open to making schedule changes if special events crop up. Don't set rigid schedules.
- ✓ 12. If speaking to your lawyer by phone, be sure the children are not within earshot. Don't bring the children to consultations with your lawyer.

- ✓ 13. **Don't discuss your case with the children or ask them to spy on the other parent.**
- ✓ 14. **Your efforts in co-parenting will leave a favorable impression with the Judge, mediator and opposing counsel that you are the parent best suited to have primary or full custody. If you believe that co-parenting will not work, discuss your concerns with your lawyer.**
